

**House Bill No. 6941**

Management to defray the cost of providing the citizens of this state with Connecticut Television Network coverage of state government deliberations and public policy events.

Sec. 359. (*Effective from passage*) (a) There is established a working group to examine the taxation of reservation land held in trust for federally recognized Indian tribes in the state and tangible personal property located on such reservation land. The working group shall consist of (1) the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management, who shall be the chairperson of the working group, (2) the chairpersons and ranking members of the joint standing committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to appropriations, local governments and finance, revenue and bonding, (3) at least one representative of each such tribe, and (4) at least one representative of each municipality that is impacted by any change to the taxation of such property.

(b) The chairperson of the working group shall schedule the first meeting of the working group, which shall be held not later than sixty days after the effective date of this section.

(c) The administrative staff of the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to appropriations shall serve as administrative staff of the working group.

(d) Not later than January 1, 2024, the working group shall submit a report on its findings and recommendations to the General Assembly, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes. The working group shall terminate on the date that it submits such report or January 1, 2024, whichever is later.

Sec. 360. Section 12-699 of the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective January 1, 2024, and applicable to taxable years commencing on or after January 1, 2024*):
