### Diversion Increase Action Steps

- Increase Police Training
- Expand use of CYFSCs including opening to JRB referrals
- Standardize JRB protocols and reporting
- Expand SBDI in schools with highest rates of expulsion and suspension (DMC impact)
- Increase use of MOA process between schools, police and OPM
