Goal: Reduce Incarceration by 30%

Recommendation 3: Reduce Use of Adult Facilities

- Based on what we have learned about the science of adolescent development, the incarceration workgroup suggests examining how 15-17 year olds who are subject to transfer to adult court will be handled, housed and treated in developmentally appropriate ways while ensuring public safety.
- With representation from victim advocate organizations, the workgroup will explore a range of issues and submit a report to the JJPOC in September 2016.
