Juveniles tested for COVID-19	19	4	7	0	11	3	<p><b>Parent/Guardian Notification:</b> Positive results and ongoing health/recovery. Nursing on-site to provide care. Pediatrician available 24/7 to respond to family inquiries. <b>PPEs:</b> All youth and staff wear masks. Focus on frequent handwashing and social distancing as possible. Additional PPE provided as necessary.</p> <p><b>Mental Health Services:</b> All youth in quarantine or isolation are on 4 minute checks. Seen by clinician at least every other day. Receive ongoing support from JDOs and detention counselors. Can still make and receive phone calls. <b>Testing:</b> Juveniles confirmed through lab testing (3-5 day turnaround). Staff tested through own provider. Rapid Antibody tests used for additional information regarding recovery of youth.</p>
