Elmore S. Banks, of Fairfield, is the son of Simon and Hannah (Dwyer) Banks and was born in Southport, May 24, 1866. He graduated from the Law Department of Yale University, Class '95. He was admitted to the Bar in January, 1895 and has since successfully followed his chosen profession. He was Town Clerk of Fairfield three years, 1893, '94 and '95, and has been Judge of Probate since February, 1896. Mr. Banks is a staunch Republican and a member of the I. O. O. F. On April 4, 1898 he married Beulah M. Gallaway, daughter of Asa B. and Pamela Gallaway of Sebree, Kentucky. Mr. Banks is Deputy Fire Marshal of the State.
