

### Town Funding From Nip Sales Over Two Years

PA 21-58<sup>1</sup> created a five-cent surcharge on each nip sold in Connecticut beginning October 1, 2021. Every April and October liquor wholesalers must remit this surcharge to each municipality and file a report with the Departments of Revenue and Consumer Protection.<sup>2</sup>

Below is a table showing the number of nips sold and the revenue generated for the first 2.5 years of the program (October 1, 2021 to March 31, 2024).
