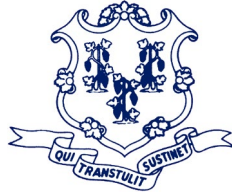

Testimony: Please email written testimony in PDF or Word format to Reapportionment@cga.ct.gov. PDF format is strongly preferred. Testimony should clearly state the testifier's name. If you do not have internet access, you may provide testimony via telephone. To register to testify by phone, call the Phone Registrant Line at 860-240-0460 to leave your contact information. The Committee requests that testimony be limited to matters related to items on the Agenda. All public hearing testimony, written and spoken, is public information. As such, it will be made available on the CGA website and indexed by internet search engines.

Testifying: Individuals who wish to testify via Zoom must register using the [On-line Testimony Registration Form](#). Registration will close on Monday, September 13, 2021 at 5:00 P.M. Speaker order of approved registrants will be listed in a randomized order and posted on the [Reapportionment Committee website](#) on Tuesday September 14, 2021 at 9:00A.M. under Public Hearing Testimony. The Committee encourages those testifying to submit a written statement and to orally summarize their testimony for no longer than three minutes. The first hour will be reserved for Legislators, Constitutional Officers, State Agency Heads and Chief Elected Municipal Officials. Unofficial sign-up sheets have no standing with the Committee.
